

305 violations against Palestinian Digital Rights

November 2025



Ongoing Censorship of Palestinian Content


Incidents of digital violations against Palestinians have persisted, primarily stemming from actions emanating from social media companies. Throughout the month of November, 7amleh documented a total of 305 violations. These encompassed 31 instances of censorship, 274 cases involving the dissemination of violent and harmful content and behaviors on social media platforms.





Forms of Censorship on Palestinian Content in Social Media Platforms

Among the most common forms of censorship imposed on Palestinian content are account suspensions and restrictions, which remain the most frequent measures. A total of 12 violations were documented involving account suspensions, along with 8 cases of account restrictions, 5 cases of content removal, and 3 instances of shadow banning, while 3 additional cases were distributed across various other types of digital sanctions.



Among the forms of digitally harmful content and practices, most are in the form of hate speech and incitement

Out of 293 documented violent pieces of content, the 7amleh recorded 165 cases related to hate speech, followed by 78 cases of incitement, 21 cases of gender-based violence, and 10 cases of smear campaigns.

Meta and X Lead in Censorship and Spread of Harmful Content

The violations and harmful content documented and monitored by 7amleh during November, were distributed across various social media platforms. However, Meta's three main platforms accounted for the largest share of violations, recording a total of 162 violations. Of these, Facebook registered 97 violations, Instagram 69, while WhatsApp recorded two cases only.

Regarding other platforms, 7amleh documented 96 violations on X, 24 on TikTok, and 17 on Telegram.





The majority of pages and accounts that were subjected to violations belong to personal accounts

During November, personal accounts (profiles) were subjected to 22 violations, including account restrictions and suspensions, while 8 violations were recorded for pages, and one violation affected another type of account.


Regarding content containing hate speech, violence, and harmful digital practices, it was published by personal accounts (profiles) in 234 cases, 23 cases on pages, and 17 cases on channels, in addition to one case on another type of account.





Digital Rights Violations in Jerusalem

Out of the total digital rights violations against Palestinians during November, 7amleh documented 14 violations in Jerusalem.
