



300 violations against Palestinian Digital Rights

December 2025



Ongoing Censorship of Palestinian Content

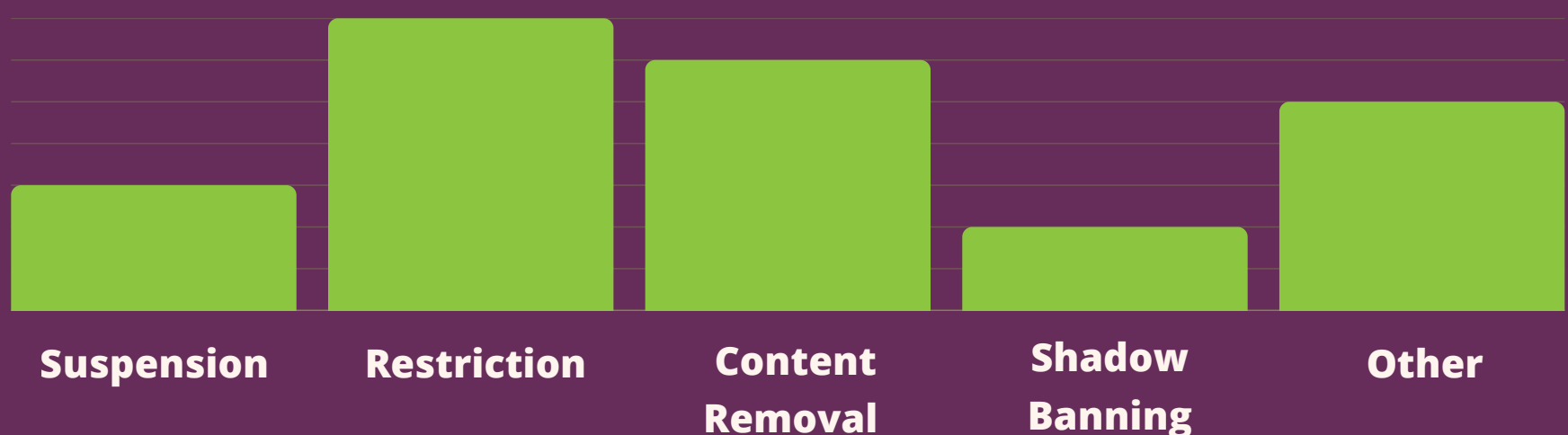
Incidents of digital violations against Palestinians have persisted, primarily stemming from actions emanating from social media companies. Throughout the month of December, 7amleh documented a total of 300 violations. These encompassed 23 instances of censorship, 277 cases involving the dissemination of violent and harmful content and behaviors on social media platforms.





Forms of Censorship on Palestinian Content in Social Media Platforms

Among the most common forms of censorship imposed on Palestinian content are account restrictions, which remain the most frequent measure. A total of 7 violations were documented involving account restrictions, along with 6 cases of content removal, 3 cases of account suspensions, and 2 instances of shadow banning, while 5 additional cases were distributed across various other types of digital sanctions.

Among the forms of digitally harmful content and practices, most are in the form of hate speech and incitement

Out of a total of 277 documented violent pieces of content, 7amleh recorded 146 violations related to hate speech, followed by 113 cases involving incitement content, and 8 cases associated with gender-based violence. In addition, 10 violations were documented involving account hacking and extortion attempts.





Meta and X Lead in Censorship and Spread of Harmful Content

The violations and harmful content documented and monitored by 7amleh during December were distributed across various social media platforms. However, Meta's three main platforms accounted for the largest share of violations, recording a total of 152 violations. Of these, Facebook registered 118 violations, Instagram 33, while WhatsApp recorded one case only.

As for other platforms, 7amleh documented 64 violations on X, 49 violations on TikTok and 12 violations on Telegram.

The majority of pages and accounts that were subjected to violations belong to personal accounts

During December, personal accounts (profiles) were subjected to 14 violations, including account restrictions and suspensions, while 7 violations were recorded for pages, along with two cases targeting channels.

As for content involving hate speech, violence, and harmful digital practices, it was published in 236 cases through personal accounts (profiles), 29 cases through pages, and 12 cases through channels.





Digital Rights Violations in Jerusalem

Out of the total digital rights violations against Palestinians during December, 7amleh documented 14 violations in Jerusalem.
